Volunteers can pre-register by sending email with the choice of time with complete personal information.

A2Z Mentoring recruits students from Elementary School, Middle School and High School. (Grade 1 through 12<sup>th</sup>). Volunteers can sign up to mentor students in summer. New students and volunteers must fill out registration form. Registration fees is applicable to all students and volunteers.

We offer peer-to-peer ACT and SAT Review Study sessions for Math, Science, and English to students from 8th grade through 11th. Students who have completed their SAT/ACT exams will mentor/tutor students seeking help. SAT/ACT Tutors will receive a special hours certificate for mentoring SAT/ACT Reviews. Leadership opportunity is also available if you willing to delegate and enroll in Peer to Peer program.
